Aunt Leah's Place



Aunt Leah's Place, based in New Westminster BC, helps foster kids who age out of the foster system to transition successfully. This means helping women avoid losing custody of their children, securing safe housing and continuing their education



CUPS



CUPS helps homeless individuals and those at risk of becoming homeless in Calgary by providing temporary housing, health care services, and education supports. In F2017, CUPS helped 96% of its temporary housing program clients secure stable housing to rebuild their lives.



East York Learning Experience



East York Learning is a tiny charity having big impact. It improves adult literacy and helps bridge language gaps for Toronto's new immigrants. Year after year, a high-impact charity along with some of the biggest charities in Canada.



Eva's Initiatives



Eva's Initiatives provides shelter and support services to youth in Toronto to address and prevent homelessness. It runs 3 shelters and provides skills and tools to keep youth safe and housed while helping them finish school, prepare for employment, and live independently.



Food Banks Canada



Food Banks Canada is a national charity that helps food banks across the country by providing food and money. In F2017, it shared 23.2 million pounds of food as well as \$7.3 million in funding for 644 food banks.



Food for Life



Food for Life, based in Burlington, ON, provides food for residents and community programs in Halton and Hamilton. For every \$1 donated to the charity, it can distribute \$15.40 worth of fresh, nutritious food for those in need while diverting the food from landfills.



Fresh Start Recovery



Fresh Start Recovery, based in Calgary, works with men who are alcoholics or addicted to drugs, helping them return to healthy, happy and productive lives. Its success rate of 53% is one of the highest across the country.



Indspire



Indspire, based in Ohsweken, ON, provides funding for Indigenous students across Canada to enroll and complete their post-secondary education. 96% of the students in their final year who received support graduated in 2017.



JUMP Math



JUMP Math helps students from kindergarten to grade 8 across Canada to learn and improve their math skills. Based on a different way of learning, last year its program helped over 179,000 students improve their confidence and performance while reducing anxiety caused by math.



Moisson Montréal



Moisson Montreal is the largest food bank in Canada, collecting food donations and distributing food to local charities that feed Montreal's poor. Moisson Montreal distributed 35.5 million pounds of food in F2017, a significant portion of which was recovered from supermarkets.
