Against Malaria Foundation



A global UK-based charity with its Canadian branch raising funds to buy mosquito nets for US\$1.60. These nets are distributed through partners in Papua New Guinea, Togo and Zambia. Mosquito nets help prevent malaria and other mosquito borne diseases.



Aunt Leah's Place



Aunt Leah's Place, based in New Westminster BC, helps foster kids who age out of the foster system to transition successfully. This means helping women avoid losing custody of their children, securing safe housing and continuing their education.



Canadian Foodgrains Bank



Canadian Foodgrains Bank tackles food insecurity by providing food for people around the world who are hungry due to emergency crisis situations like war, droughts, or floods. It also provides training and assistance for farmers to increase yields. It works primarily in Africa and Asia.



Doctors Without Borders



Doctors Without Borders delivers life-saving medical assistance in countries around the world that are torn apart by war, disease, and natural disasters. It provides vaccines, medical interventions, surgeries and medical treatments.



CUPS



CUPS helps homeless individuals and those are risk of becoming homeless in Calgary by providing temporary housing, health care services, and education supports. In F2017, CUPS helped 96% of its temporary housing program clients secure stable housing to rebuild their lives.



East York Learning Experience



East York Learning is a tiny charity having big impact. It improves adult literacy and helps bridge language gaps for Toronto's new immigrants. Year after year, a high-impact charity along with some of the biggest charities in Canada.



Fresh Start Recovery



Fresh Start Recovery, based in Calgary, works with men who are alcoholics or addicted to drugs, helping them return to healthy, happy and productive lives. Its success rate of 53% is one of the highest across the country.



One Drop Foundation



One Drop provides access to safe drinking water and hygiene facilities to people in Africa, India, and Latin America with poor access to clean water and sanitation. One Drop provided clean water to 478,500 people in 2017, preventing water borne diseases, improving health and saving lives.



JUMP Math



JUMP Math helps students from kindergarten to grade 8 across Canada to learn and improve their math skills. Based on a different way of learning, last year its program helped over 179,000 students improve their confidence and performance while reducing anxiety caused by math.



Operation Eyesight



Operation Eyesight Universal provides eyecare for people in developing countries to prevent blindness and restore vision. Operation Eyesight provided glasses, cataract and other surgeries, as well as drug programs to help eliminate avoidable blindness to people in India, Nepal, Kenya, Ghana, and Zambia.
